You will see a new face around the Parish! Father Daniel Wojtun will be residing at the St. Francis Rectory. Father will be helping out around the Parish until assuming duties as Chaplain for the Hospital of Central CT in New Britain upon the retirement of the current Chaplain, Father Ron Smith, at the end of this year. When you see Father Dan, please say hello and give him a warm welcome!

We asked Father Dan to tell us about himself: "I am Father Daniel Wojtun from Poland. I moved to America to SS Cyril and Methodius Seminary in Orchard Lake, Michigan, where I finished my studies. I was ordained by Archbishop Henry Mansell on July 7, 2007 for the Archdiocese of Hartford, where I have served different parishes. I have been a parochial vicar, hospital chaplain, administrator, and pastor of two parishes in Broad Brook and East Windsor, CT for a period of three years. In 2019, I needed to leave the Archdiocese in order to take care of my parents in Poland. Then covid struck and my stay in my country was prolonged due to the shutdowns. After time consuming immigration procedures, I am back at the Archdiocese of Hartford. My assignment is to be a hospital chaplain in New Britain as well as Mid-state Hospital in Meriden. In the meantime, I will help Father Casey at St. Francis."
