### SACRAMENT PREPARATION CONFESSION/COMMUNION CONFIRMATION

Classes are forming now to prepare your child for the Sacraments.

FIRST COMMUNION will take place on Sunday, May 17th. Preparation classes will be family-based, with Father Casey working directly with the families of students wishing to go to Confession and to receive Communion. Children must be in 2nd grade or above.

CONFIRMATION preparation will feature a mentor/discipleship program connecting candidates with faithful college students or young adults. Candidates must be in 10th grade (or above) in fall, 2020 to receive the sacrament of Confirmation.
