Marie-Francoise-Therese Martin was born in France on January 2, 1873. She became a nun at the Carmelite convent at 15, after a long battle with the superior and even appealing to the pope. She died at 24. In 1895, the prioress had commanded Therese to write her memoirs. A year after Therese's death, the memoirs were published in a small edition which sparked a "storm of glory" that swept the world. Miracles started to happen: conversions, cures, even apparitions. Therese was canonized in 1925. Saint Therese was physically weak and psychologically vulnerable. Therese' "Little Way" means taking God at His word and letting His love for us wash away our sins and imperfections. We all have daily opportunities of grace. The more we love God, the more we will see them.
